- Youth Day of Caring (YDOC) is school based and open to area students in grades 7 – 12.
- · YDOC is held rain or shine!
- Each school will provide their own transportation to your agency and should arrive between approximately 8:30 - 9 a.m. At approximately noon, the school bus/vehicle from each respective school will pick up students from the assigned agency(ies) and transport them to the **Greater Scranton YMCA** for lunch.
- Each agency will collect signed release forms from the student volunteers when they arrive at your facility. A signed release form is required for ALL YDOC participants.
- Although lunch is provided, please supply the student volunteers with refreshments.
- Your agency is responsible for all supplies/materials needed by the student volunteers to accomplish their assigned task(s) while at your facility.
- You are responsible for the student volunteers while they are working at your facility. Please ensure a safe environment.
- If a medical emergency/accident should happen, follow your normal procedure for handling such occurrences and inform the United Way (570.343.1267) immediately.
- Photographers and/or members of the media may be visiting your agency during YDOC. Please be accommodating to them and steer them away from anyone at your facility who cannot be photographed/recorded.
- Once the volunteer assignments are made, you will be contacted with the representative(s) from your assigned school(s). Please work with them for all details, directions, etc.
